Graduation Attire and Regalia:

Alaska Airlines Arena Information:

Parking:

- Parking is paid for by graduates and families.
- Parking will be in E18 parking lot (biggest parking lot). Parking: Most of the lots are self-serve parking. On 6/15, event parking will be \$12.50 in E18 (the big lot).
- The closest ADA lot for the arena is E17.

Venue:

- Students and staff to enter through Loading Dock with security checks.
- Family and Guests to enter through main entry doors.
 - 1. Doors to the arena to open 1-hour prior to graduation to guests.
 - 2. Empty water bottles are OK and encouraged for guests to bring.

- No other food/drink
- Tickets No assigned seating.
- UW will provide ushers to help facilitate seating in the arena.
- UW will provide security at door for bag checks.
- Guests can bring personal items into the arena, and there will be bag checks for purses, backpacks, and diaper bags. Flowers are allowed. <u>NO balloons</u>, firearms, or alcohol.
- Graduating Class Located on the main arena floor.
