

ATTENDANCE

- Attendance is taken in all your classes
- Students are expected to attend Homeroom on Thursdays, ACT on Wednesdays, and all assemblies (we do find a quiet place for students who find assemblies difficult*).
- 5 tardies leads to attendance workshop during ACT
- Admin is now identifying students who are missing one or more period of unexcused absences

ATTENDANCE

Hanging out in cars during any part of the day will result in a loss of parking permit privileges, parent/guardian will be contacted, and an office referral written.

HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS

- No passes during the first five or last five of a class period
- One student out at a time
- Students will: sign out, take the pass, be gone for less than 5 minutes
- Teachers will: notify admin when pass is missing/student has been gone for too long.
- Different types of passes:
 - Yellow paper passes library, different classroom, health room
 - Plastic lanyard pass bathroom
 - These are color coded based on floor/area of classroom

HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS

- Students who chronically abuse hall pass privileges will be put on a "seatbelt*", parent/guardians notified, and receive an office referral.
 - *seatbelt: students unable to leave during class w/o an adult escort for up to 10-15 school days.

BATHROOM EXPECTATIONS

- use closest bathroom (if full, notify teacher and ask if you can use another one)
- one person to a stall, in an out, flush, wash hands, head straight back to class
- Bathrooms are a vape, alcohol, tobacco and drug free zone
- Report graffiti, report unsafe behavior (safe schools poster include QR code and visual of poster))
- Vapes: must be 21 or older in the state of Washington
 - Suspicion of vaping or drug use will trigger a search by admin
 - Items will be confiscated
 - In-school suspension and drug and alcohol, tobacco education will be required
