WASHINGTON STATE GUARANTEED ADMISSIONS PROGRAM

WHAT IS THIS?

The Guaranteed Admission Program (GAP) is a pilot that our school district is participating in. The district is partnering with five colleges in Washington (Central Washington University, Eastern Washington University, Washington State University, Western Washington University and The Evergreen State College) to offer this program. We have outlined the specific criteria for each school below:

CRITERIA FOR GUARANTEED ADMISSIONS PROGRAM:

- Have a qualifying cumulative GPA (varies by college-see below)
 - Central Washington University -3.0
 - Eastern Washington University -3.0
 - o The Evergreen State College −2.5
 - Washington State University −3.0
 - Western Washington University −3.0
- Complete the necessary
 College Academic Distribution
 Requirements (CADR) courses
 in high school (most students
 will meet this requirement,
 please contact your school
 counselor if you are unsure).

How can a Student Participate in the Guaranteed Admissions Pilot?

If a student meets the criteria or is on track to meet the criteria by high school completion, they are guaranteed admission to the institution. Students eligible for guaranteed admission must complete an admission application and additional requirements by the institute after receiving an admission letter. This is an opt-out program which means that student information will be shared with these institutions to ensure that every student who may meet the criteria will be able to benefit from this program.
