

COMMUNITY COLLEGE / HIGH SCHOOL COURSE EQUIVALENCIES:

Please use the chart below when planning how you will complete JHS graduation requirements through participation in the Running Start program. Note that not all courses are offered at all community colleges. Remember, not every class is offered every quarter at each college. It is in your best interest to cover graduation requirements as soon as possible to make sure you do not miss an opportunity to take a class needed for graduation! In addition, Cascadia Community College does not offer Physical Education classes. **Courses numbered 099 or below are not considered part of RS and will not be funded nor counted as college credit,** however these courses may still count for high school credit. Consult with your JHS counselor when choosing classes to meet your high school graduation requirements.

• US HISTORY	HIST&146, HIST&147 or HIST&148
MATH:	ANY MATH COURSE OVER THE 100 LEVEL
SCIENCE:	ANY SCIENCE COURSE OVER THE 100 LEVEL
WORLD LANGUAGE:	ANY WORLD LANGUAGE COURSE OVER THE 100 LEVEL
HEALTH:	FTNS102, HLTH250 or NUTR&101
OCCUPATIONAL:	ANY BUSINESS, COMPUTER, TECHNICAL, OR OTHER CLASS AS AGREED UPON WITH HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR
PHYSICAL EDUCATION:	ANY PE COURSE (CASCADIA DOES NOT OFFER PE)
FINE ARTS:	ANY ART, DRAMA OR MUSIC COURSE ABOVE THE 100 LEVEL
ELECTIVES:	ALL OTHER COURSES OVER THE 100 LEVEL

When planning which college classes to take, keep in mind that college credit amounts convert into different amounts of high school credit:

College Credit	High School Credit
5	1.0
4	0.8
3	0.6
2	0.4
1	0.2

- There are three college quarters per school year (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- Full time RS students are eligible for 15 tuition free college credits per quarter
- The number of tuition free college credits part time students are eligible for is dependent on the number of courses enrolled in at high school
